(PROOF OF RESIDENCY IS REQUIRED)

ACCEPTABLE LIMITS AND AMOUNTS:

- 25 Gallons of liquid chemicals
- 25 Pounds of dry chemicals

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Pesticides, Polishes, Waxes, Wood Strippers, Wood Stains, Pool Chemicals, Photo Chemicals, Drain Cleaners, Brake Fluid, Muriatic Acid, Degreasers, Car Wax, Antifreeze, Old Gasoline, Creosote, Wood Preservative, Solvents, Sealants, Oil Paint, Ni-Cd Batteries, Fluorescent bulbs

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

Latex Paint, Electronics, Asbestos, Motor Oil, Propane Tanks, Explosives, Radioactive Waste, Fire Extinguishers, Car Batteries and Smoke Detectors

The following items can be disposed of at the Recycling Center, 500 Primrose Street, Haverhill, MA. For on-line payments, pay online and print receipt for onsite attendant at the Recycling Center front office. Checks will also be accepted onsite (no cash accepted).

- **Motor Oil:** Last Saturday of each month from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. Five (5) gallon limit - no charge.

Wednesday and Saturdays 8:00 am to 1:00 pm

- **Appliances and Scrap Metal:** Hot water heaters, dishwashers, dryers, washers, stoves, microwaves, refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners. **\$15.00 per appliance.**
- **Tires:** Tires DO NOT have to be off the rims. **A fee of \$5.00 per passenger and \$10.00 per Truck tires.**
- **Propane Tanks:** **Cost is \$5.00 each.**
- **Mercury Containing Products:** **no charge**
- **Car Batteries:** Dispose of at Haverhill Salvage, 81 Hale Street, (978) 372-6900.
