

This facility is open for Phase 3.1 in accordance with the Massachusetts 4-Phase State Reopening Plan and is subject to the restrictions below as laid out by Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker. Duration of these restrictions is unknown.

All Residents are asked to please respect the following restrictions associated with this facility in order to maintain the safety of yourselves and others:

- This facility is open for practices, games, and scrimmages upon acquisition of permits from the Haverhill Recreation Department.
- All activities where social distancing cannot be maintained are prohibited.
- Maximum group size of 25 people including all coaches and staff and everyone needs to remain at a minimum of 6 ft apart including spectators.
- Multiple groups may use this surface but groups must be 20 ft apart and everyone must remain in the same group throughout the session.
- Total number of people including coaches, staff, participants, referees, and spectators shall not exceed 50 people.
- Masks must be worn by coaches, staff, and spectators at all times.
- Participants must wash or sanitize hands before and after session.
- NO sharing of equipment and all equipment must be sanitized after use.
- NO loitering before or after sessions.
- NO high fives, fist bumps, or other social contact.
- Non-contact drills only.
- There is limited bench access please reference posted signs where allowed.
- All items are subject to a “carry-in, carry-out” policy. Take out whatever you bring in.
