

**This facility is open for Phase 4 Step 1 in accordance with the Massachusetts Reopening Plan and is subject to the restrictions below as laid out by Massachusetts Governor Charlie Baker. Duration of these restrictions is unknown.**

All Residents are asked to please respect the following restrictions associated with this facility in order to maintain the safety of yourselves and others:

- The following types of activities are permitted: Non-contact Practices, Competitive Practices (intra-team games, contact drills, scrimmages), and Competitions (inter-team games). Tournaments are **not** currently allowed. All organized events must obtain a permit from the Haverhill Recreation Department.
- Facial coverings are required for all players, spectators, coaches, staff, referees, umpires and other officials at all times. This includes benches and sidelines. Frequent facial covering breaks are encouraged but all individuals must spread out by at least 10 feet in order to avoid incidental contact.
- Masks are to be utilized according to *COVID-19 Order 55: Revised Order Requiring Face Coverings In Public Places*
- Residents must sanitize hands before and after use of the facility.
- Sanitize all equipment after use.
- Benches, bleachers, dugouts require participants to maintain 6 feet of distance in these areas. Do the varying size and scope of such areas across the City of Haverhill, signs have been posted at each area with occupancy limits.
- No congregating or loitering in groups before or after activities.
- Please try to take out everything you bring onto the court; shirts, shoes, water bottles, etc.
- No alcohol.
- No high fives, fist bumps or other social contact.
